Dreams With Wings Summer Camp FAQ 2025

PROCESS

- We have limited spots based upon facility space, transportation, and staffing.
- We review all applications for returning campers first and then identify available spots for new campers.
- We review all applications to ensure that we have adequate camper to counselor ratios because safety is our top priority during both onsite and offsite community based activities.
- NOTE: Missing or incomplete documentation may delay acceptance to summer camp.
- Communication is sent to each family about whether or not a camper has been enrolled in camp this
 year.

TIMELINE

- 3/1/25 summer camp applications will go live on our website, https://www.dreamswithwings.org/services
- 3/1/25 New campers can apply
- 4/22/25 New camper applications and all required documentation is due (Camp Policy, Consent, Behavior Plans if applicable)
- 5/9/25 Notifications sent confirming whether or not a camper has been enrolled in camp this year
- 6/3/25 Tentative Parent Orientation for all Dreams In Motion camper families
- 6/5/25 Tentative Parent Orientation for all Achieving Dreams camper families
- 6/09/25 Achieving Dreams Start Date
- 6/10/25 Dreams In Motion Start Date
- 7/25/25 Both camps end date

ATTENDANCE OPTIONS

- Summer camp is a 7-week commitment.
 - We staff, rent space, and rent transportation to accommodate the full capacity of our campers who apply and are accepted.
 - Each camper spot is filled for all 7 weeks.
 - o There are no fill-in spots available.
- Full-Time is defined as attending 4 or 5 days a week for the entire 7 weeks of camp.
- Part-Time is defined as attending 2 or 3 days a week for the entire 7 weeks of camp.
- We do not offer a 1 day a week option.

FEES

CAMPER application fee is \$215 and is due when confirmation of enrollment has been sent and accepted.

TUITION

Private Pay

- Defined as using non-Michelle P Waiver Respite funds.
- Weekly tuition rates are dependent upon the selected and accepted attendance option:
- Part-Time (PT)-Weekly Rates
 - o 2 days a week for the entire 7 weeks of camp -\$240
 - o 3 days a week for the entire 7 weeks of camp -\$270
- Full-Time (FT) -Weekly Rates
 - o 4 days a week for the entire 7 weeks of camp -\$320
 - o 5 days a week for the entire 7 weeks of camp -\$400

 Coordination with your Case Manager is needed to allocate funds based upon your full-time or part-time selection.

Quick facts about summer camp

- This is a day camp and not an overnight camp.
- We are staffed to have a ratio of 3 campers to 1 counselor and are not able to provide one-on-one supports.
- Summer camp is not structured like school:
 - o There is a calendar of events for each day with onsite and offsite activities planned.
 - o Campers cannot elect to stay onsite if offsite activities are planned.
 - There is planned downtime to allow campers to have breaks during the day.
 - o All camp activities begin at 9:00 A unless otherwise noted in the schedule.
 - All Camp activities end at 3:00 P unless otherwise noted in the schedule.
